## THE PATH OF THE TWO CASTLES

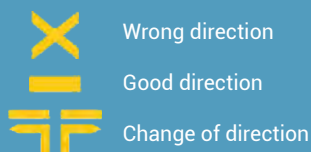

- ❶ From the picnic area, take the path on the left, then the road to the left again. Follow the Tolosane road to the village.
- ❷ At the public weight, turn right towards the mill. Turn left at n ° 13, then left again to take the venelle\*. Go through the gate to arrive in front of the hall. Head right, towards the castle.
- ❸ Follow the Allée du Rempart.
- ❹ Take the Chemin d'En Guit, slightly to the right, then continue straight. At the crossroads, turn left towards En Mittou. To cross the bridge to get to the D67.
- ❺ Cross the road and continue straight on on the Chemin de Roquette. At the Tuilerie, go up the path bypassing the large cedar. Continue on the path, which bypasses the castle park.
- ❻ Go through the park entrance gate and continue until you reach the stairs leading to the rampart walk. Take the path to the right, and go around the church. Take the alley then turn right, and then left on a paved path. At the end, turn right to take a new alley \*. Go along the rampart wall to the right.
- ❼ At the sign, turn left towards En Boudou. At the crossroads, continue slightly to the left, still towards En Boudou. At the next crossroads, turn left towards En Trempat. Continue straight on towards En Buc. Follow the D67 for 50m, then turn right towards En Courbet. After the bridge, turn to right towards La Cabane.
- ❽ In Cabane, take the path back to the castle.
- ❾ Go right along the moat to reach rue de l'église. Return to the right towards the starting point.

\* A **venelle** is a narrow little street.
