♥ Avignonet-Lauragais

In this quiet little village, it is difficult to imagine that one of the bloodiest episodes in the history of Catharism in our region took place here: the massacre of the Inquisitors.

What were they doing in Avignonet and why were they murdered in their sleep?

Your tour guide will tell you all about this episode in Occitanie history.



A village with festive traditions

Bourg-Saint-Bernard

Did you know that this charming village on the banks of the Girou has the oldest festival in France?

Throughout the tour, from the woad dye to architecture to the history of Saint-Bernard de Clairvaux, your guide will also passionately recount what has bound the inhabitants of the village together for centuries: the Fête du Pré de la Fadaise, celebrated for 5 days over the Whitsun weekend.



In the footsteps of the Protestants

♥ Calmont

Situated at the crossroads of the Ariège, Aude and Lauragais regions, Calmont was founded in the 13th century. At that time, both the Count of Foix and the Count of Toulouse claimed sovereignty!

But it wasn't until the 16th century, with the birth of Protestantism, that the fate of the bastide shifted to a long period of suffering and war.

From the Church to the temple, learn more about this turbulent past, forever marked by the Wars of Religion.



On the edge of the Lauragais

Caraman

Mentioned as far back as the early 11th century, the village of Caraman sits proudly in the Lauragais countryside.

Marked by the many episodes of war, and those more sumptuous of the d'âge d'or of Pastel and wheat, Caraman still preserves the traces of this tumultuous past which will be told to you with passion by our guide!



The past comes back

♥ Villefranche de Lauragais

Villefranche de Lauragais is located on an important traffic route linking Toulouse and Narbonne, known since antiquity as the famous "Via Aquitania". Since the Middle Ages, the bastide has played a key role in the flourishing pastel and wheat trade.

Follow us, and you'll never see the city the same way again!



A royal bastide in Lauragais

Montgeard

His bastide was built on the initiative of the King of France in the year of grace 1317. The village enjoyed great prosperity in the 16th century, thanks to the cultivation of pastel. The magnificent church, in which the pastel merchants are buried, and the beautiful town house date from this period.

You'll be seduced by this village, which has retained all its d'antan charm!

♥ Montesquieu-Lauragais

Village of Ravachou!

♀ Auriac-sur-Vendinelle

Just a few kilometers from Caraman, Auriac-sur-Vendinelle is an ancient Gallo-Roman villa built around its 11thcentury chateau. Your visit will take you between the church and the medieval bridge.
